BOROUGH OF ENGLISHTOWN ORDINANCE NO. 2023-10

PUBLIC HEARING AND ADOPTION

AN ORDINANCE OF THE MAYOR AND COUNCIL OF THE BOROUGH OF ENGLISHTOWN AMENDING CHAPTER 2.130 OF THE BOROUGH CODE

WHEREAS, pursuant to N.J.S.A. 40:55D-62, the Mayor and Council submit this Ordinance to amend the Borough's zoning ordinance (Chapter 2.130) to effectuate the February 15, 2023 Master Plan & Development Regulations Reexamination performed in accordance with N.J.S.A. 40:55D-89, and adopted by the Unified Planning/Zoning Board.

PURPOSE

The purpose of this Ordinance is to amend certain portions of the Zoning Ordinance, in accordance with an updated Zoning Map, to effectuate the redevelopment plans of the municipality.

SECTION 1

The Chapter 2.130, Zoning, shall be amended as follows:

§ 2.130

The boundaries of the zoning districts are to be modified in accordance with an updated "Zoning Map of the Borough of Englishtown" dated 2023, which shall be kept on file in the office of the Borough Clerk. The 2023 Zoning Map shall be amended to provide that the block between Pine Street and Center Street, areas along Main Street, all of Water Street up to Lasatta Avenue, and all of Tennent Road up to Harrison Avenue, shall be redesignated as Commercial Zones subject to §§2.130.13, 13.1 or .14 of the Zoning Ordinance.

SECTION 2

All Ordinances or parts of Ordinances inconsistent with this Ordinance if held to be unconstitutional or invalid for any reason shall not affect the remaining portions of this Ordinance.

SECTION 3

The Borough Clerk is hereby directed, upon adoption of the Ordinance after public hearing, to publish notice of its passage and to file a copy of this Ordinance as finally adopted

with the Monmouth County Planning Board as required by N.J.S.A. 40:55D-16. The Clerk shall also forthwith transmit a copy of this Ordinance after final passage to the Borough Tax Assessor as required by N.J.S.A. 40:49-2.1.

SECTION 4

This Ordinance shall take effect immediately upon final passage and publication according to law and filing with the Monmouth County Planning Board.

- 7. Any pending or anticipated litigation or contract negotiation wherein the public body is, or may become a party. Any matters, falling within the attorney-client privilege, to the extent that confidentiality is required.
- 8. Any matter involving the employment, appointment, termination of employment, terms and conditions of employment, evaluation of performance of, promotion or disciplining of any specific prospective public officer or employee or current officer or employee, employed or appointed by the public body.
- 9. Any deliberations of a public body occurring after a public hearing that may result in the imposition of a specific civil penalty upon the responding party or suspension or loss of a license or permit.

WHEREAS, N.J.S.A. 10:4-13 provides that a public body may not exclude the public from any meeting to discuss any matters described in N.J.S.A. 10:4-12 until the public body has adopted a resolution at a meeting to which the public shall be admitted, stating the general nature of the subject to be discussed and stating as precisely as possible, the time and when the circumstances under which the discussion conducted in a closed session of the public body can be disclosed to the public.
